## **ENROLLMENT 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR**

St. Vincent de Paul Enrollment has begun for the 2021-22 School year. In order for students to be completely enrolled, we have both hard copy forms and online registration through our Powerschool Student information System that need to be completed. Both parts are equally important. The hard copy forms can be found on our school website <a href="www.mystvincentschool.com">www.mystvincentschool.com</a> and they were sent with students a few weeks ago. The online registration instructions can be found at the bottom of the newsletter. There are instructions for both new and returning students, however, returning students will need a Snap Code in order for parents to begin the online registration process. Those letters will be coming out this week in the Friday Folder.

- Each enrolling student will receive a \$400.00 Scholarship award, (first three students) towards tuition.
- Each enrolling student will receive a \$130.00 Scholarship award per student applied to the technology fee.
- Both of these scholarships are awarded at the beginning of the first semester of the 2021-22 school year.
- Parents may select to pay bi-monthly (20 payments) monthly (ten payments), by semester, or all at once.
- Total awards per student = \$530.00 (first 3 students)
- Total paid by parent per student = \$1950.00 (first 3 students)
- Each student after the first three adds \$200.00

Base Tuition for the 2021-22 school year was set at \$2150.00 per student up thru the first three students. After the family cap of three, any subsequent students in the same family household will attend tuition free.

Technology fee was set at \$330.00 per student. No family cap

If a family has a greater need for assistance, the Good Shepherd and Guardian Angel Scholarships are available to apply for. Deadline is March 31.

#### GOOD SHEPHERD SCHOLARSHIP

St. Vincent de Paul Parish will benefit from families who apply for the Good Shepherd Scholarship through the Diocese. The Good Shepherd Scholarship is open for applications beginning Jan. 1, 2021 and closes on March 31, 2021.

## Online Registration Instructions Returning Students for the 2021-22 school year

## **RETURNING STUDENTS-**

The Catholic Diocese of Lincoln is pleased to announce the online registration Returning Student Form. The forms that parents update each year for children returning to St. Vincent de Paul for a new school year can now be completed online!

#### How do I get started?

A Snapcode will be sent via an email from PowerSchool InfoSnap with your child's Snapcode and instructions for completing the online Returning Student Form. If you don't receive the snapcode, you may contact the school and we can provide it over the phone. You may also receive the snapcode via a USPS letter or hardcopy.

#### What's a Snapcode?

The Snapcode is like a key to your child's Returning Student Form for the upcoming school year. You should receive a unique Snapcode for <u>each child.</u>

#### Should I create an account?

If you've never completed an online Returning Student Form with PowerSchool Registration, you should create an Registration Account. This allows you to securely save your work and come back at a later time if necessary. You can use your email address or cell phone number. If you already have an account, you can sign in and complete the form. (You should use the same account to complete forms for multiple children.)

#### Do I have to answer all the questions?

Questions marked as "required" must be completed.

#### I've changed my address or phone number. What should I do?

As part of the online registration Returning Student Form you will have the opportunity to update the student home address.

#### I've completed the form, now what?

When you have finished entering your information, click "Review & Submit." This will send all of the information you've entered to the school. If you cannot click on this button, you will need to make sure that you have answered all required guestions.

#### What if I have more than one student in the school? Do I need to do this for each child?

Yes, because you'll need to provide information that is specific for each child. We recommend that you submit one Returning Student Form and then start another – this will allow you to "snap over" shared family information, which will save you time.

# **Preschool Enrollment for 2021-2022**

Preschool classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. Capacity for 3-4 yr.-old children is 10; 4-5yr.-old children is 12 (per section). The dates listed for each group is when priority enrollment for that group ends; you can still enroll after that date, but will not be guaranteed a spot. Please return form with a \$25 enrollment fee.

- 1. Jan. 19 25 Current 3-4 yr. old Preschool Students of St Vincent's and or Potential Preschoolers who have siblings enrolled at St Vincent de Paul School
- 2. Jan. 26 Feb 1 Preschool Children of St. Vincent de Paul Parish Families
- 3. Feb 2 Enrollment is open to the Public

# **Enrollment Requirements**

- 1. \*Admission Form (new students only) see attached
- 2. \*\$25 non-refundable registration fee
- 3. Your child's **original** Birth Certificate -We will make a copy. (new students only)
- 4. Immunization Records (new students only)
  - \*Needed to reserve your child's spot.

# **Payment:**

Payments are due the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month – August through May. Tuition payments are collected through St Vincent's automatic debit program from checking or saving accounts. Payment options are one time a month on the 5<sup>th</sup> or two times a month on the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 20<sup>th</sup>. Please complete the E-tuition enrollment form found on back and return it with your registration.
